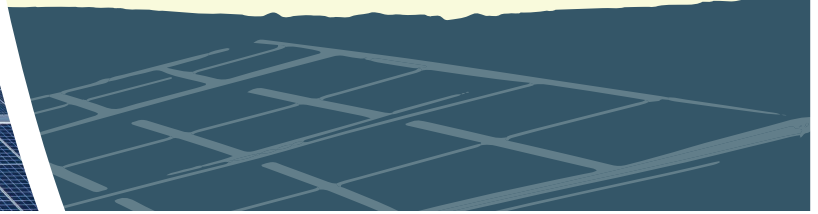

EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT

We are proud to have funded a National Curriculum Framework and Resources workshop, which benefitted 15 ECD centres, within the Ramotshere Moiloa Local Municipality.

The workshop equipped ECD supervisors and practitioners with fundamental knowledge necessary for working with infants, toddlers, and young children up to the age of four. The supervisors and practitioners also learned how to identify materials and objects that can be used to create teaching and learning resources for children of different ages and stages in ECD.

A significant aspect of the workshop was aligning teaching practices with the six Early Learning Developmental Areas. Each ECD centre received planning posters to help them to develop comprehensive and well-rounded educational plans.

YOUTH SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

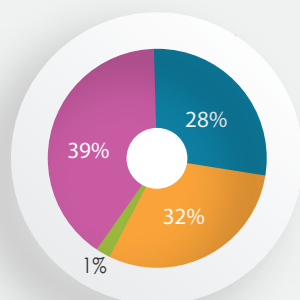
